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#### Introduction

The ELLIS Basics Student Workbook is for true beginning, pre-literate, young adult and adult ESL learners. It follows ELLIS Basics lesson by lesson to build upon what is taught in the program. There is no new instruction presented in this book; it instead provides reinforcement activities and practical opportunities to practice writing and using material learned in ELLIS Basics.

The activities in the ELLIS Basics Student Workbook are designed to strengthen beginning literacy, numeracy, and writing skills. Workbook activities can be done in class, as homework, with a tutor, or with peers. They can be used as take-home assignments and for additional practice away from the computer. Teachers may need to initially explain workbook activities to students. However, workbook lessons provide a consistent format to allow non-literate learners to become comfortable completing exercises on their own, without the need for continued assistance from the teacher.

ELLIS Basics is designed for students who have had no prior exposure to English. It reinforces beginning language and literacy acquisition using an integrated skills approach. Like the computer-based instruction, the Student Workbook is divided into two sections: Vocabulary and Reading. Each section has nine lessons. Vocabulary lessons provide extensive practice in Letters, Numbers, Vocabulary, and Communication. Reading lessons reinforce the sounds and phonemic awareness skills taught in ELLIS Basics. An answer key for the Reading section can be found in the Instructor Guide.
